








Connecting the handset/telephone line cord



- Not ringing when there is incoming call.

Important:

Do not activate Message Waiting Lamp function from PBX system while using this unit.


- This unit may not work properly when there is message waiting lamp signal from PBX system. It might keep displaying "CALL-In" even there is no incoming call.



Using Caller Id service Important:

 This unit is Caller ID compatible. To use Caller ID features, you must subscribe to Caller ID service. Contact your service provider/telephone company for details.

Caller ID features

When an outside call is being received, the caller's phone number is displayed. Caller information for the last 30 callers is logged in the caller list from the most recent call to the oldest. If the unit cannot receive caller information, the following is displayed.

- "Out of AreA": The caller dialed from an area which does not provide Caller ID service.
- "PrivAte CALLEr": The caller requested no to send caller information.
- "Long diStAnce": The caller made a long distance call.

Note:

 Above display may not appear. It depends on compatible type of Caller ID.

Missed calls

If a call is not answered, the unit treats the call as a missed call. The display shows the number of missed calls while the unit is not in use. This lets you know if you should view the caller list to see who called while you were away. If there are unviewed missed calls, number of missed calls will be displayed in standby mode.

Viewing the caller list and calling back

- Press [v] to search from the most recent call, or [A] to search from the oldest call.






Wall mount setup
